Re: Claim for Payment under Cable Franchise Bond #08951557

Dear Sir/Madam:

On November 11, 2008, Comcast of Maine/New Hampshire, Inc., as Principal, and Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland, as Surety, issued a Cable Franchise Bond, #08951557, that named the Town of South Berwick, Town Council, as the Obligee in the sum of \$100,000. The purpose of the bond was to ensure that the Principal would perform its obligations as created by a Franchise Agreement between the Principal and the Obligee, dated September 8, 2008. A copy of the bond and the Franchise Agreement are enclosed herewith.

Under the terms of Section 3.1 of that Franchise Agreement, the Principal was required to build out a cable system within certain sections of the Town of South Berwick within twelve months of the date of the Franchise Agreement. As of this date, the Principal has failed to complete, or even to undertake, that obligation. The Principal has estimated that the cost of compliance for the required build out will be approximately \$485,725.74. The required build out was a material term of the Franchise Agreement, as well as an inducement for the Obligee to enter into the Franchise Agreement with the Principal.

Based upon the Principal's failure to comply with the requirements of Section 3.1 of the Franchise Agreement, the Obligee hereby requests payment to it of the full amount of the Cable Franchise Bond #08951557. This request was authorized by vote of the South Berwick Town Council on September 3, 2009.
