The Town Manager reported the following to the Clerk:

Chairman Gerald W. MacPherson, Sr. called the meeting to order at 6:33pm. Those present included Councilors Jean Demetracopoulos, David H. Webster, and John C. Kareckas. Town Manager Perry A. Ellsworth was also in attendance. David Burke was not present.

NEW BUSINESS

1. On a motion by Mr. Kareckas, seconded by Mr. Webster, it was unanimously voted to enter executive session pursuant to 1MRSA §405.6A to discuss the **Town Manager's contract**.

On a motion by Mrs. Demetracopoulos, seconded by Mr. Webster, it was unanimously voted to end the executive session.

ADJOURNMENT

On a motion by Mr. Webster, seconded by Mrs. Demetracopoulos, it was unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 7:52pm.

South Berwick Town Council December 13, 2011

Chairman Gerald W. MacPherson, Sr. called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Councilors present included, David Burke, Jean Demetrapoulos, David H. Webster, and John C. Kareckas. Town Manager Perry Ellsworth was also in attendance.

Approval of Minutes

1. Council 11-29-11: On a motion by Mr. Webster, seconded by Mr. Burke, it was unanimously voted to adopt the minutes as written.

Treasurer's Warrant – Dec 13, 2011

On a motion by Mrs. Demetrapoulos, seconded by Mr. Kareckas, it was unanimously voted to sign the warrant in the amount of \$1,123,437.89.

Public Comment

1. Abigail Gindele, Old South Rd, asked the Council to ban the use of fireworks in South Berwick. She went on to explain that there are numerous issues to consider including safety, noise, and the effects on wildlife and domestic animals. Mr. MacPherson stated that the Council will be looking at a possible ordinance.

Reports & Correspondence

1. Letter from Margaret Linnell (SB Vet) - Business Directional Signs: Tom Vollert was present to discuss the issue on behalf of the Veterinary Hospital. Mr. Vollert stated that they would like to have Business Directional Signs on Portland Street. He referenced the existing signs such as "Signs by Mo". **Mrs. Demetrapoulos explained that several years back the Council decided that the signs would be prohibited because of the State's requirement that the signs be placed at all intersections leading up to the business.** The concern at the time was that businesses not located near the town center would require and result in numerous signs all over town. Mrs. Demetrapoulos added that the existing signs were grandfathered when the ordinance was changed. It was the consensus of the Council to have **the Manager verify the State's current requirements for the signs and then to consider whether an ordinance change to allow them would be in order.**

2. Letter from Priscilla Schmidt – Ms. Schmidt has asked that the Town not allow fireworks. It was agreed to include her concerns in future discussions regarding an ordinance.

3. Letter from Planning Board: The Planning Board expressed its concerns for the lack of professional assistance.

Town Manager's Report

-Made note that he spoke with Southern Maine Regional Planning (SMRPC) regarding professional assistance for the Planning Board. An agreement between South Berwick and SMRPC for the services of J. T. Lockman is in the works; and will be kept within budget.

-The library project is moving along and December 31st is the anticipated completion date. The project is still under budget at this point. Mr. Ellsworth also commented that RICCI has done a very good job on the project.

-Commented that thus far in 2011 the Police have made a total of 1825 traffic stops, with 522 stops on Portland Street and 388 stops on Route 236.

-Made note that he is in discussions with another town to add them to our Police dispatch center. The addition of another town would help salvage our dispatch by sharing the cost amongst three towns. [We currently provide dispatch services for Berwick]

-Received consensus to hold a budget workshop on Tuesday, December 20th at 6:30pm.

Unfinished Business

1. On a motion by Mr. Burke, seconded by Mr. Webster, it was unanimously voted to approve the **amendments to the Manager's contract as written.**

Mr. Ellsworth stated that the amendments do not include a pay increase; however there are changes to benefits, primarily vacation and retirement, and a continuing 2 year contract with an annual performance evaluation. The contract currently runs through June 2013.

New Business

1. On a motion by Mr. Webster, seconded by Mr. Kareckas, it was unanimously voted to approve **the renewal of the liquor license for Fogarty's Restaurant.**

2. On a motion by Mr. Burke, seconded by Mrs. Demetracopoulos, it was unanimously voted to accept the \$1291.00 Byrne Grant (for portable narrow-band radios for the Police Department). The Town portion is \$261.00.

3. On a motion by Mr. Webster, seconded by Mr. Kareckas, it was unanimously voted to accept the equipment donation of 2 IMMI Smart Dock SCBA Seat Brackets for the Fire Department, with thanks, from **the Firefighter's Association.**

Council Member Comments

1. Mr. Burke:

- Thanked the Manager for the inspirational words included in the weekly packets.
- Asked everyone to take the time to relax and enjoy the season.
- Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

2. Mr. Webster:

- Commented that he has been asking **people how they've been** affected by the \$253,000 cut from the budget. Those he has spoken with have not been affected at all.
- Commented that it is nice to see people out and about downtown in the evenings.
- Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

3. Mrs. Demetracopoulos:

- Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

4. Mr. Kareckas:

- Made note of a resident suggestion: cut a window into the false wall at the new library and insert a clear Plexiglas box for donations. It would be nice to see the funds growing as people drop money in the slot.
- Commented that he would like to get away from split position budgeting.
- Commented that he was glad to hear that the Planning Board would have some professional assistance from SMRPC.
- Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

5. Mr. MacPherson:

- Made note that the program Maine Watch (on MPBN) about the history of the old and new library has been postponed again.
- Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

Adjournment

On a motion by Mr. Webster, seconded by Mrs. Demetracopoulos, it was unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 7:50pm.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to 2008 the Town's Zoning Ordinance conflicted with regard to these signs. • At the time, MDOT required a sign at each intersection leading to a business from all directions. • During 2007 the Planning Board worked on this issue with the Council. • The Planning Board's recommendation was to prohibit all new OBDS in South Berwick (existing signs were grandfathered). • The Council held a public hearing on 8.25.08. • The Ordinance was amended on 9.8.08 to prohibit OBDS in all zones in South Berwick. <p>We have contacted MDOT for an updated ruling on these signs. At this time, no more than 6 signs are allowed. If there is more than one way to a business, MDOT asks the business to identify which direction will bring more traffic and requires the signs be placed at turns from that point. If the ordinance is amended to allow OBDS use, the signs will be placed by MDOT in neighborhoods when required.</p>

RE: Official Business Directional Signs revisions.

The Planning Board at the August 7, 2007 meeting agreed to prohibit off-site, Official Business Directional Signs in all Districts. They are prohibited in Table A, but exempt in the section that provides for the signs. In order to resolve this contradiction, the Planning Board agreed to strike the exemption for the MDOT signs.

1. Official Business Directional Signs are defined in:

ARTICLE II Construction of Language and Definitions

Section. 140-8. Construction of Language.

OFFICIAL BUSINESS DIRECTIONAL SIGNS: A sign erected and maintained in accordance with the Maine Traveler Information Services Act, [23 M.R.S.A. Sec. 1901 et seq.,] which points the way to public accommodations and facilities.

2. In Table A these “Official Business Directional Signs” are Not Permitted in all Districts.

3. These signs are exempt (strikeout to be deleted) in all districts under:

ARTICLE V General Performance Standards

Section. 140-26. Signs. D. In addition, signs in the all districts are subject to the following provisions:

(4) The following signs are exempt from the above provisions: memorial tablets, public notices, public safety signs, on premise real estate signs, flags and insignia except when displayed in connection with a commercial promotion, religious symbols or insignia, historical plaques, house numbers, political signs, ~~motor vehicle signs requiring Maine DOT approval in accordance with the Maine Travelers Information Service Act,~~ temporary (30 days or less) banners, signs on vending machines or newspaper racks and interior signs.
